NOTES ON THE COMPILATION: This is by no means exhaustive; we left out public institutions by and large, and probably missed a lot of businesses as well, though we tried hardest on restaurants and bars, and the creative sector. Among these, we omitted most TV and radio stations, whose call letters have stayed the same, even as ownerships have bounced around. (On the other hand, movie theatres omitted themselves: apart from the Paramount, not a single one is still operating, unless you count the Alamo North, a renovation of the former Village Cinemas 4.) Also, take some of the dates with a grain of salt; some places have not been in business continuously since the date listed, but in most cases, we've gone with what the business claims.
